INSTALLATION

- > Mount Angled Handlebar Risers to steering post and tighten bottom mounting bolts. Use an adequate thread locker on bolt threads.
- > Install handlebars onto risers and position them to your desired position and tighten down handlebar clamp bolts. Use an adequate thread locker on bolt threads.
- > Make sure you have proper function of all controls including throttle cable, brake line, and steering function before operating snowmobile.
- > Go Snowmobile!

See chart below for proper steering post drilling for your specific make of snowmobile.

Arctic Cat	No drilling required
Polaris	Drill out steering post holes to 5/16" Ski-
Doo Rev	Drill out steering post holes to 21/64" and do not install Lock washer.
Ski-Doo ZX	Drill out steering post holes to 23/64"
Yamaha	Drill out steering post holes to 3/8"
