

Polaris P-22 Clutch Cover Instructions

(123-171, 123-172, 123-173)

- -Remove Clutch side body panel.
- -Loosen all (6) M6 primary clutch cover bolts. Only take (3) all the way out. NOTE: Apply pressure to the primary clutch cover when removing the last (3) bolts.
- -You will reuse the (6) OEM M6 bolts.
- -Install new cover onto clutch.
- -Torque the M6 bolts to the manufacture's specification.
- -place side panel back on the sled and you are ready to ride.
